- I traveled by boat
- I had two to three boats per voyages
- I am pretty sure I had good conditions on board, but I think some of my sailors caught scurvy, dysentery and other sicknesses

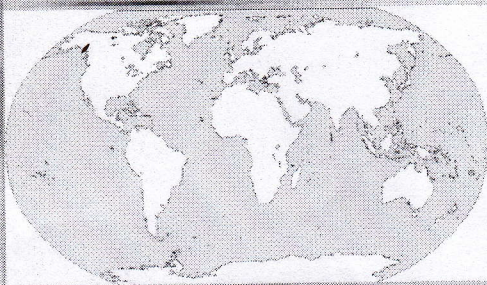
6. Interesting facts

- I gave Kanata its name (to evolve to Canada), which means small village

- The name of my ships were Grande Hermine and Petite Hermine, which means Big Ferret and Small Ferret
- I met a tribe which called themselves Micmacs, which now means "confusion" in French
